



## FAQ Internships At Chikumbuso

Chikumbuso hosts many interns at Chikumbuso during the year. It is very rewarding to find niche needs within our community that allow you to use your unique skills to help our community grow and learn. Volunteers in the past have done projects like this:

- Made flash cards and helped teach the students in Grade 3 multiplication
- Took over the art program in the absence of a permanent art teacher, rotating through the entire school so that each class had a chance to do an art project once a week
- Taught the children a new sport after school over the course of several weeks
- Helped start an after school program
- Created a student database for the sponsorship program
- Offered computer training to at risk youth

Interns at Chikumbuso find friendship and support from the on site staff and experience a good amount of freedom for downtime and exploration of Lusaka. We ask our interns to bring a donation of \$1000 as an investment and commitment to our ongoing work.
